Plus, a strong Wi-Fi connection is often faster than a mobile network, and using wireless requires less battery power than surfing on a mobile network. Optimizing your battery can extend the life of your cell phone, so you don't have to replace it quite as often. Speaking of that...

### Resist the urge to upgrade your phone every two years
